## Technical Requirements

### Audio

The console comes with a regular stereo, line-level audio output: 1/8" (3.5mm). This output connects directly to your mixer or sound equipment using an audio cable.

### Video

This console is equipped with HDMI and DisplayPort video outputs. S-Video, Component, and Composite video output requires a separate adapter. A video distribution system is recommended. Contact Control Play Support if you have any questions about your video connections.

### Internet

A direct, hard-wired connection from your router or modem is recommended for the most reliable performance. The internet connection download speed should be a minimum of 3 Mbps for optimal results.

### Electrical

To maintain warranty coverage for electronic components, ensure the console is plugged into a surge protection device. For maximum protection and reliability, an Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) is recommended—this can be purchased at any electronics or computer store.



# Setup and Installation

## 1. Unpack the Control Play Console and Cables



### Notes:

- Your Control Play Console can be placed horizontally or vertically
- If being placed in an AV Rack Shelf, we recommend 3U or more

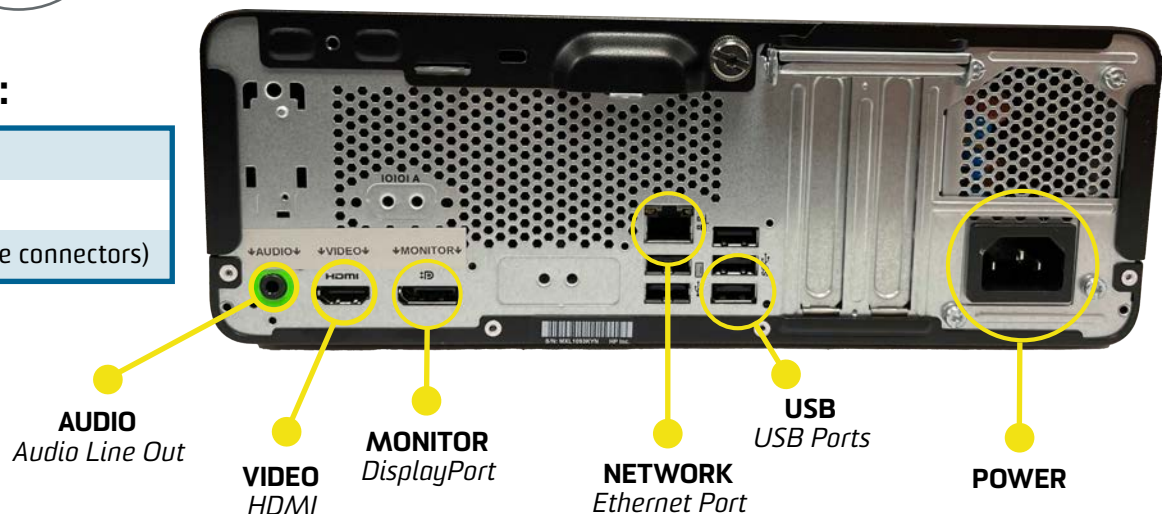

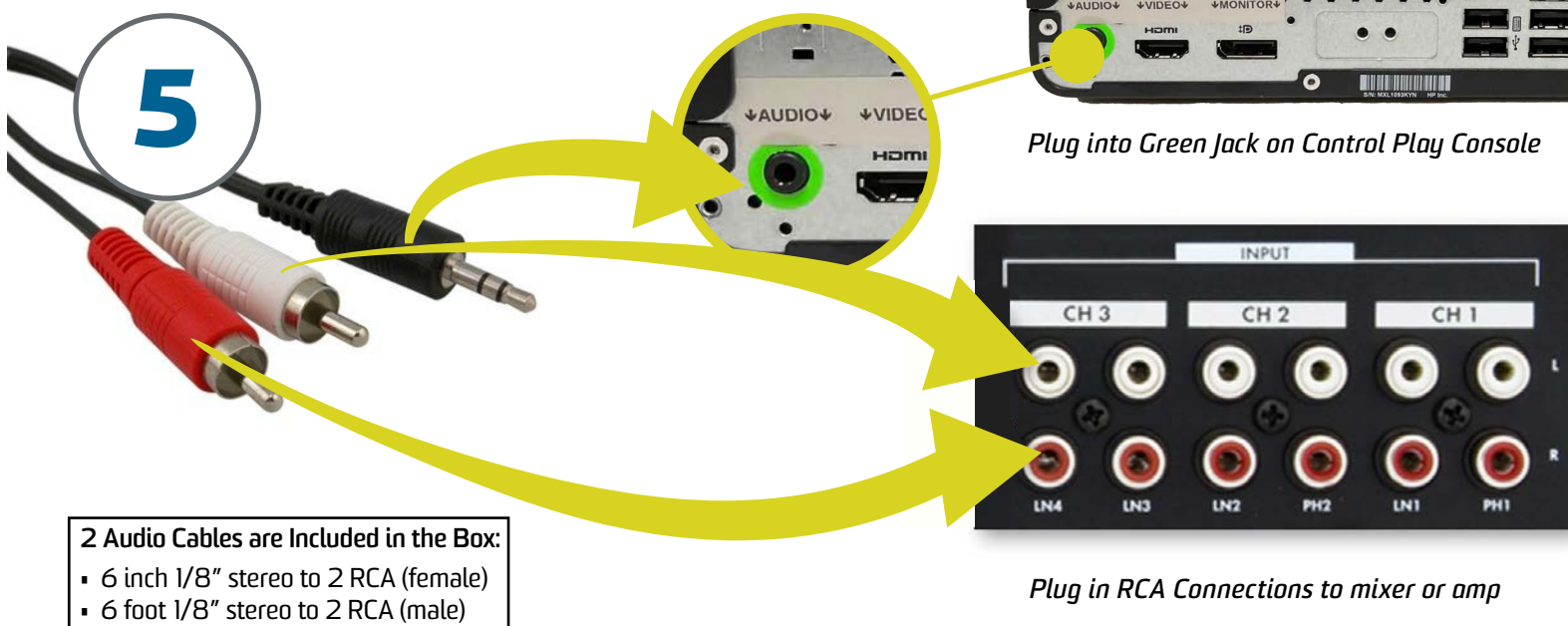
## 4. Connect sound system

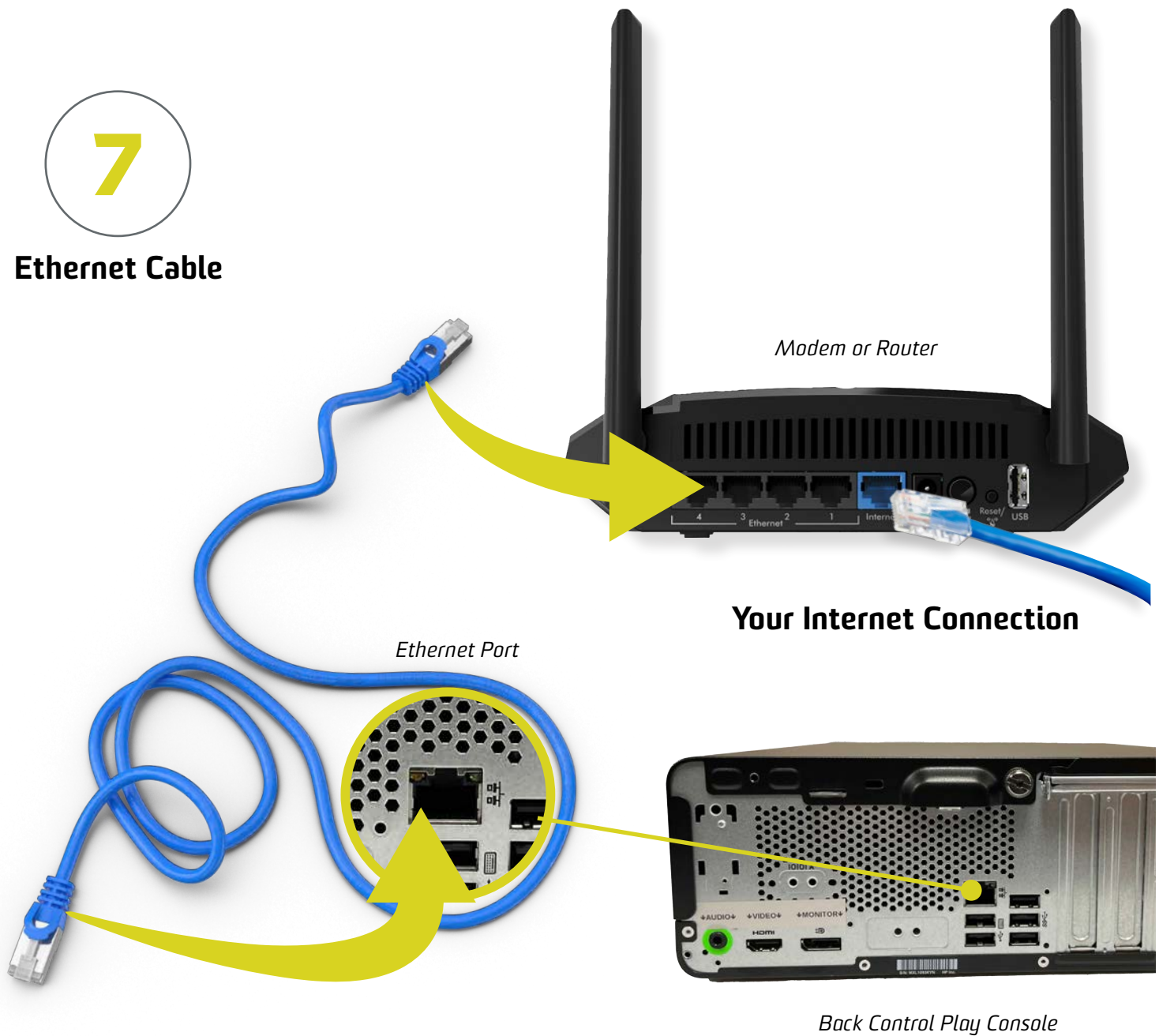

### Ethernet Cable

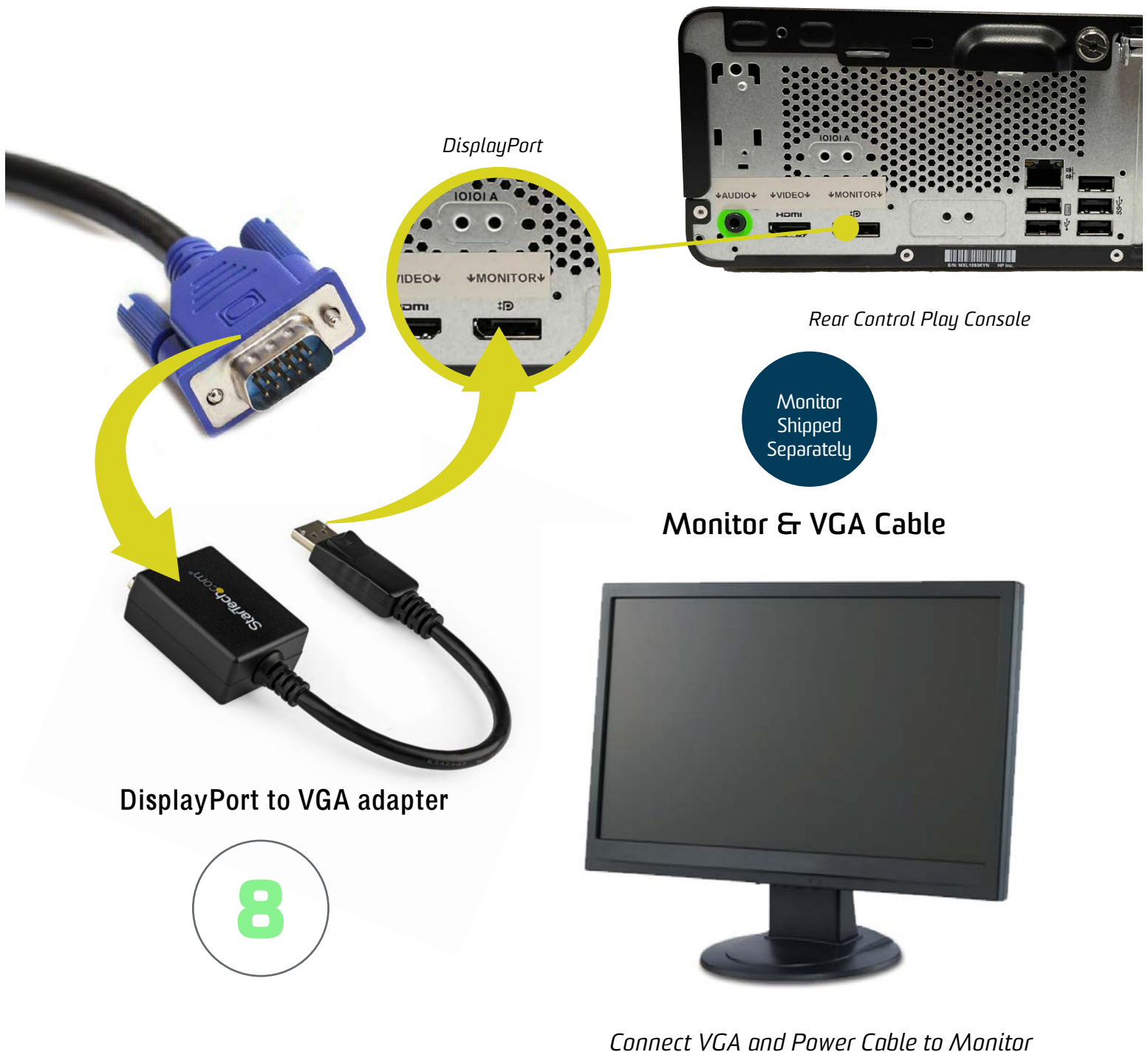


#### NOTES:
